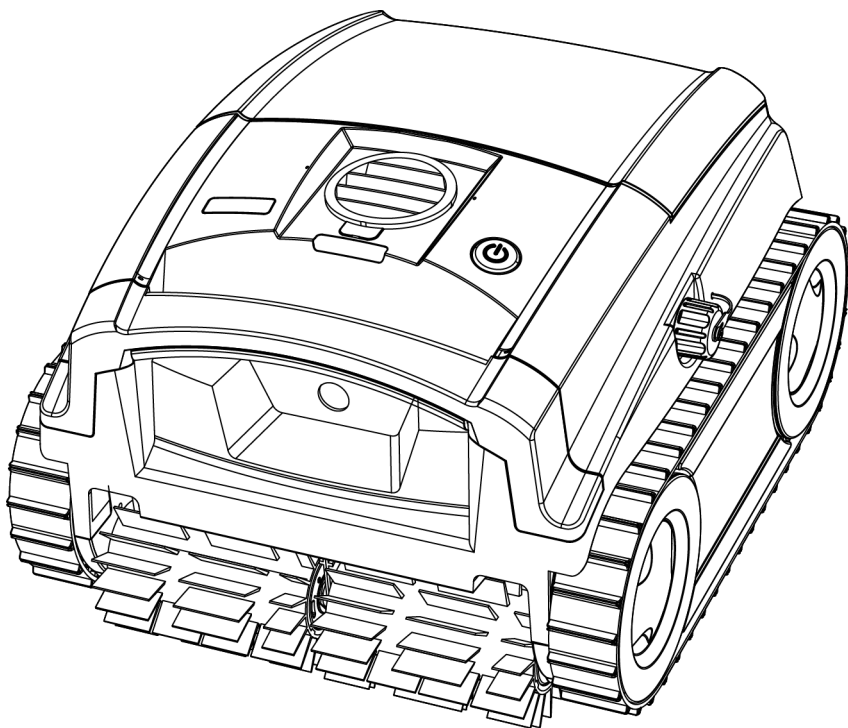

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# Section 1. Important Safety Instructions

When installing and using this electrical equipment, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

## READ AND FOLLOW ALL INSTRUCTIONS

- **WARNING** - To reduce the risk of injury, do not permit children to use this cleaner unless they are closely supervised at all times.
- Ensure that children do not attempt to access the cleaner while it is operating.



## WARNING

- Failure to comply with the following warnings can result in permanent injury, electrocution or death.
- Improper operation may void the warranty.

### Operation Restrictions

- Please read the user manual carefully, especially the safety instructions, and make sure you fully understand them before using the cleaner. Carefully follow the instructions on operation, maintenance and repair. The manufacturer shall not be held liable for any loss or injury resulting from improper use.
- This cleaner is not suitable for use by children under 8 years of age and people with physical, sensory or mental functional limitations or inexperienced people who are not familiar with the cleaner. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not ride on or play with the cleaner as a toy, even when it is not in operation.
- Only use original accessories supplied by the manufacturer with this cleaner. The manufacturer shall not be held liable if non-original accessories are used. Failure to comply with this requirement may seriously endanger the health and safety of people.
- After powering on the cleaner and selecting the mode, put the cleaner into the pool within 30 seconds; otherwise the indicator will show a steady red light.

- Never use the cleaner while the pool filtration system is in operation, as this may cause damage to both the cleaner and the filtration system.
- Never enter the pool while the cleaner is in water.
- Always power off the cleaner immediately when it is removed from the water to prevent motor damage caused by dry operation.
- Non-professional personnel are forbidden to disassemble the cleaner's sealing box, as this may endanger the health and safety of people and cause damage to the cleaner.
- Never pierce the cleaner's shell with nails or other sharp objects, and never hammer, hit or throw the cleaner.
- The motor oil seal contains grease. If the grease leaks, it may cause slight water pollution. Stop using the cleaner immediately if any leakage is detected, and contact customer service promptly.
- After dispensing pool chemicals, wait at least 24 hours before using the cleaner. This prevents corrosion or damage to the cleaner. Never use the cleaner to dispense chemicals, as this may cause internal corrosion or functional failure.

### Maintenance

- Always clean the filter basket immediately and thoroughly after each use to maintain optimal cleaning performance and extend the cleaner's lifespan.

### Battery & Charging

- Use only the original battery charger supplied by the manufacturer with this cleaner. Improper use may cause electric shocks, overheating or leakage of corrosive liquids from the battery.
- Before charging, confirm the cleaner is powered off and the charging port is dry.

- During charging, both the battery charger and the cleaner must be placed indoors or in a splash-resistant enclosure at least 5 feet (1.5 meters) from the edge of the pool, with a temperature between 41°F (5 °C) and 95°F (35 °C), out of reach of children, pets, other foreign objects, etc.
- Never cover the battery charger and the cleaner with any objects during charging, as this may cause overheating.
- Only connect the battery charger to a receptacle protected by a ground fault circuit interrupter (GFCI).
- Never charge the cleaner near flammable materials (e.g., paper, cloth, chemicals), excessive temperatures or heat sources (e.g., heaters, ovens).
- Never expose the cleaner to fire.
- Charge the cleaner before its battery completely runs out. Additionally, when the cleaner's yellow indicator light is on, charge it promptly.
- Never charge the cleaner when its battery is full. Overcharging will shorten the battery's lifespan.
- If the battery charger is damaged, have it replaced by the manufacturer or an authorized dealer. Do not attempt to service the battery charger. A damaged cord can lead to contact with live parts.
- Never attempt to disassemble the battery pack. The battery can produce a short circuit causing severe burns. Avoid contact between any wires or metal items that could cause sparking and short circuit the battery.

### Long-Term & Winter Storage

- Drain all water to avoid freezing water damage (freeze damage is not covered under warranty).
- Rinse the filter basket with clean water, air-dry it completely, then reinstall it inside the cleaner.
- Charge the cleaner to 40%-60% capacity once every 3 months (do not fully charge or discharge the battery for long-term storage).

### Disposal of Li-ion Batteries

- This cleaner contains a maintenance-free, rechargeable lithium-ion battery pack, which must be disposed of properly. Recycling is required.

## 3.4 Mode Selection

### 3.4.1 Full Pool Mode

- After powering on, the cleaner will automatically enter “Full Pool Mode”. The cleaner will first clean the pool walls, then the pool bottom, then the pool walls again, then the pool bottom again, until it runs out of power.
- To switch to another cleaning mode, press the power button after the mode panel light turns on.



### 3.4.2 Floor Only Mode

Press once after “Full Pool Mode” light turns on to switch to “Floor Only Mode”. The cleaner will clean the pool bottom only.



### 3.4.3 Wall Only Mode

Press once after “Floor Only Mode” light turns on to switch to “Wall Only Mode”. The cleaner will clean the pool walls only.



### 3.4.4 Waterline Mode

Press once after “Wall Only Mode” light turns on to switch to “Waterline Mode”. The cleaner will clean the waterline only.



**NOTE:** After selecting the mode, put the cleaner into the pool within 30 seconds.

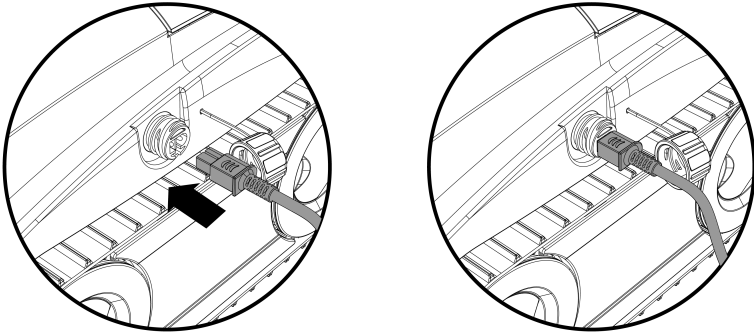
# Section 4. General Cleaner Operation

## 4.1 Charge

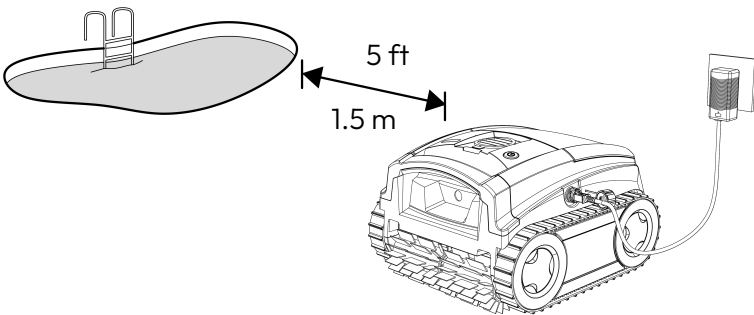
Before each use, please fully charge the cleaner.

### 4.1.1 Charging Operation

- Before charging, ensure the cleaner is powered-off (all indicator lights are completely off).
- Unscrew the waterproof cap (confirm the charging port is dry first) and connect the battery charger to a receptacle protected by a ground fault circuit interrupter (GFCI).

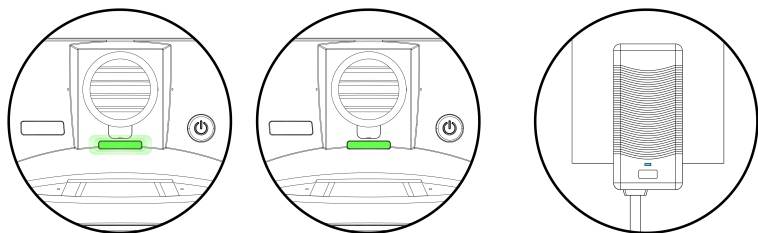


- Both the battery charger and the cleaner must be placed indoors or in a splash-resistant enclosure at least 5 feet (1.5 meters) away from the edge of the pool during charging.



#### 4.1.2 Charging Indicator

- A flashing green light: the cleaner is charging.
- A steady green light: the cleaner is fully charged.



**NOTE:** The charger's indicator will show a steady blue as long as it is powered on.

## 4.2 App Connection

### 4.2.1 Download the App

**NOTE:** Ensure your mobile phone is running iOS 14 or later, or Android 8.0 or later.

Method 1:

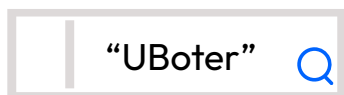
Scan the QR code below. After scanning, you can choose the corresponding store (Apple's App Store or Google Play) to download the App.



Method 2:

Download the App from an App store

- For Android phones, search “UBoter” in Google Play and download.
- For iPhones, search “UBoter” in Apple’s App Store and download.



### 4.2.2 Preparations Before Connecting to the App

Open the “UBoter” App and follow the on-screen instructions in the App to complete the preparations before adding a device, including:

- 1) Allow Bluetooth access (ensure your Bluetooth version is 5.0 or above);
- 2) Allow Wi-Fi access (ensure the current Wi-Fi network is a 2.4 GHz single-band network. 5 GHz single-band and 2.4 GHz / 5 GHz dual-band merged networks are not supported);

3) Read and agree the Privacy Policy;

4) Create an account and log in.

#### 4.2.3 Add a Device

1) Bring your cleaner close to your mobile phone (within 3.3 feet / 1 meter);

2) Remove the cleaner from the water and power on the cleaner with the indicator showing a steady blue light, or charge the cleaner with the indicator showing a steady green light or a flashing green light;

3) Open the “UBoter” App and tap the “ + ” icon on the home page to add a device.

**NOTE:** The App will automatically search for nearby devices. When the cleaner is found, follow the on-screen instructions to connect via Bluetooth and complete network pairing. After pairing is completed, assign a name to the cleaner to finish adding the device.

### CAUTION

The App cannot be connected while the cleaner is operating in the water.

#### 4.2.4 Setting the Cleaner in the App

After connecting to the App, select the desired cleaning mode and cleaning time in the App.

**NOTE:** After the settings are completed, put the cleaner into the pool within 30 seconds. The cleaner will automatically start cleaning according to the selected settings.

### CAUTION

The cleaner cannot receive signals when it is underwater. Once working, you cannot pause cleaning.

## 4.2.5 Firmware Upgrade (OTA)

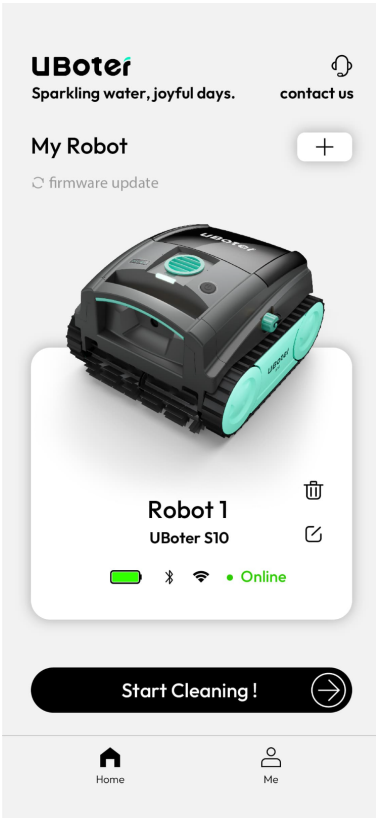
### 1) Preparation for upgrade

The cleaner firmware can be upgraded when the cleaner is in either of the following states:

- The cleaner is powered on with the indicator showing a steady blue light
- The cleaner is charging with the indicator showing a steady green light or a flashing green light.

### 2) Firmware upgrade procedure

Open the UBoter App, enter the home page, tap “Firmware Update” and follow the on-screen instructions to complete the firmware update.



### NOTICE:

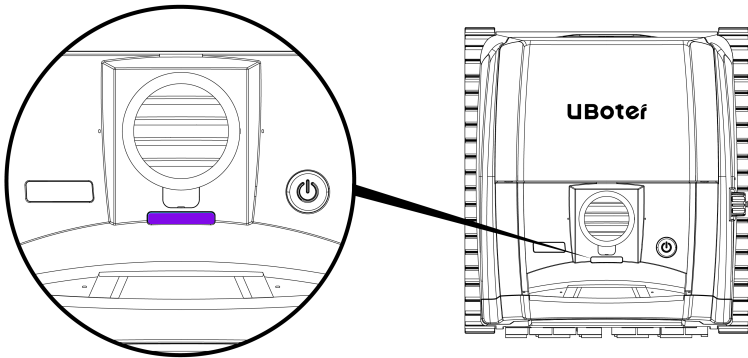
- The OTA upgrade does not affect normal charging.
- If the charger is not connected, make sure the cleaner has sufficient battery power before upgrading.

# IMPORTANT

- During an OTA firmware upgrade, the cleaner should be connected to the charger or powered on without charging.
- If the cleaner is connected to the charger, do not disconnect the charger during the upgrade.
- If the upgrade is performed while the cleaner is powered on and not connected to the charger, the red indicator light may remain on due to the out-of-water alarm. This is normal and does not affect the upgrade.
- After the upgrade is completed successfully, the cleaner will automatically power off.

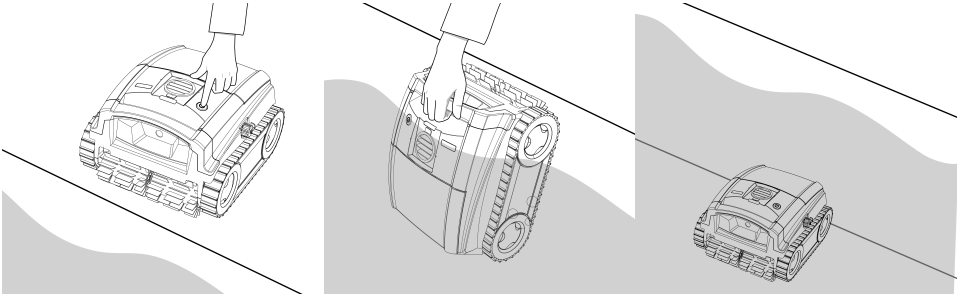
### 3) Initialization After Upgrade

After the upgrade is complete, press and hold the power button to restart the cleaner. Upon restarting, the purple indicator light will turn on, indicating that the cleaner is initializing system data. Once initialization is finished, the cleaner will automatically power off. The cleaner is now ready for normal operation.



### 4.3 Start the Cleaner

- Press and hold the power button for 3 seconds to power it on. Release the button until the indicator light turns steady blue and the buzzer sounds for 2 seconds.
- Put the cleaner into the pool within 30 seconds after powering it on, with its bottom facing towards the wall; hold the handle and press the cleaner into the water.



#### **CAUTION**

Ensure the waterproof cap for the charging port is fastened securely; otherwise, water may get into the charging port, which could affect the cleaner's charging function.

#### **CAUTION**

When placing the cleaner in water, ensure its front faces upward and its bottom faces the pool floor. If the cleaner flips over during operation, correct its orientation promptly. Once ready, the cleaner will automatically clean the pool.

#### **WARNING**

Do not enter the pool while the cleaner is in water.

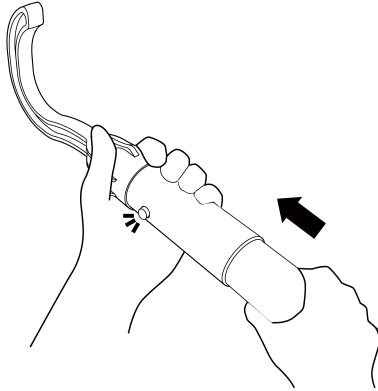
## 4.4 Retrieve the Cleaner

### 4.4.1 Auto-Park

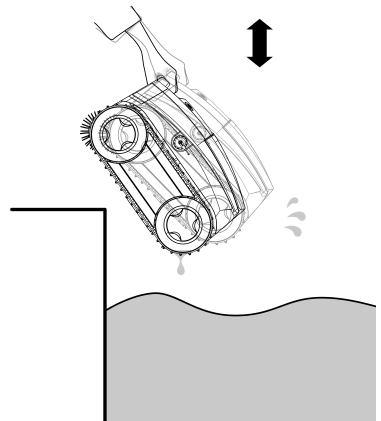
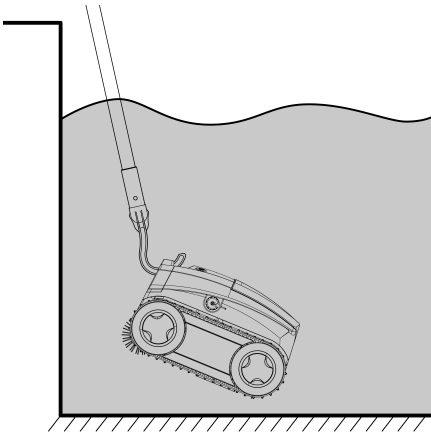
When the battery is low, the cleaner will automatically return to the pool wall for easy retrieval.

### 4.4.2 Retrieval

- Attach the hook to a standard pole (not included).



- Hook the cleaner's handle and bring it to the waterline.
- Press and hold the power button for 3 seconds to power off the cleaner.
- Pull up the cleaner by the handle and hold it vertically to let the water drain into the pool.

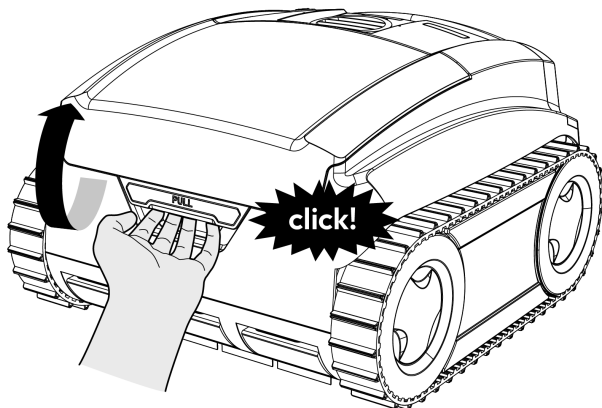


## 4.5 Maintenance

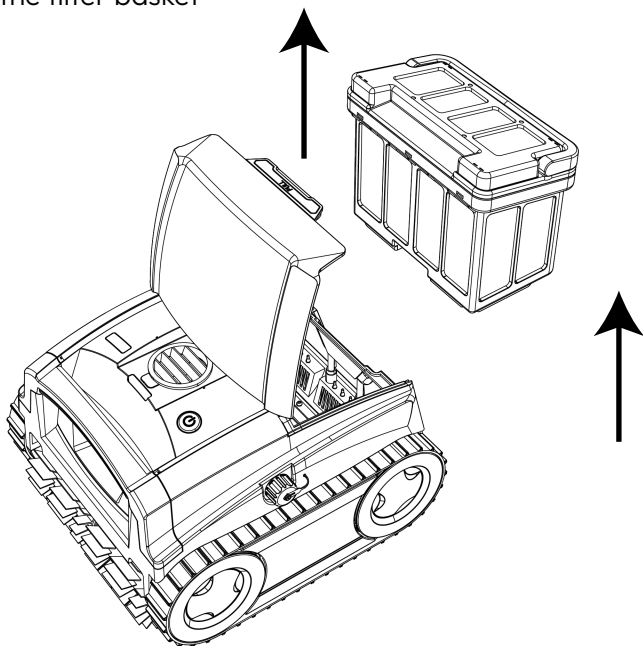
The filter basket should be cleaned immediately after each use.

### 4.5.1 Flip open the cover

Pull the latch on the back side of the cleaner and flip open the top cover.

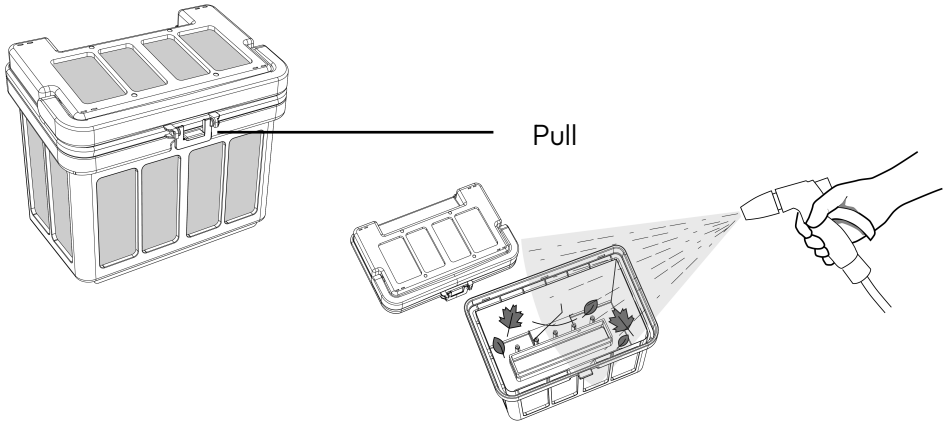


### 4.5.2 Remove the filter basket



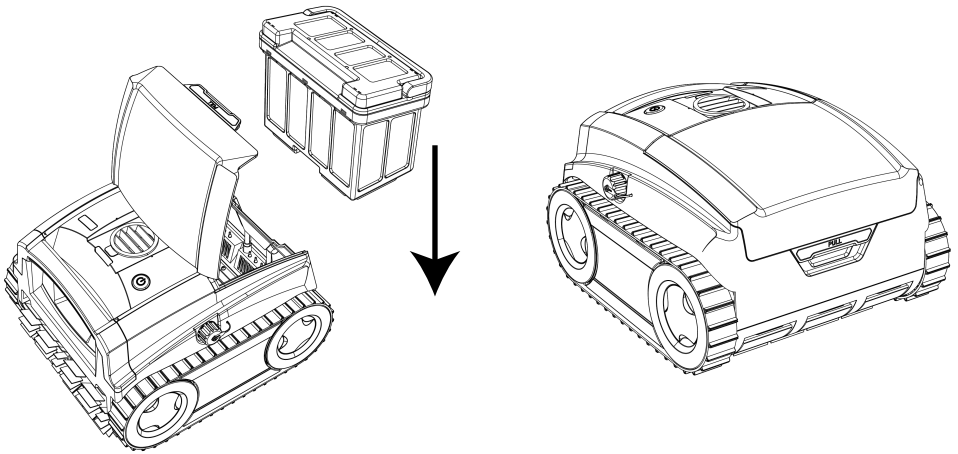
#### 4.5.3 Rinse the filter basket

- Pull the latch of the filter basket to separate it.
- Empty all debris from the filter and bottom tank. Then rinse the filter basket and the bottom tank with a hose or water gun.



#### 4.5.4 Reinstall the filter basket

After cleaning, install the filter basket in the correct orientation.



**NOTE:** Clean the filter basket before debris dries.

## Section 5. Storage

- Store the cleaner in a cool, dry, and well-ventilated indoor area, away from direct sunlight, rain, frost, with a temperature between 41°F (5°C) and 95°F (35°C), out of reach of children, pets, other foreign objects, etc.
- Never store the cleaner near flammable materials (e.g., paper, cloth, chemicals) or heat sources (e.g., heaters, ovens).
- Never expose the cleaner to fire or excessive temperature.

### **Long-Term & Winter Storage**

- Drain all water to avoid freezing water damage (freeze damage is not covered under warranty).
- Rinse the filter basket with clean water, air-dry it completely, then reinstall it inside the cleaner.
- Charge the cleaner to 40%-60% capacity once every 3 months (do not fully charge or discharge the battery for long-term storage).
